SPOTLIGHT: Thompson Island Outward Bound and Orchard Gardens K-8

75 Orchard Gardens K-8 students board a boat in South Boston every morning and ship over to Thompson Island for a day complete with learning, adventure, and enjoyment. Recently, these rising 6th and rising 7th graders worked on their individual data projects on the shore - collecting information ranging from number of crickets to the timing between airplanes overhead. Students will soon plot and graph their collected data. Taking a break in the shade, students collaborated to solve math problems aligned to the grade-specific ANet standards. Part of their calculations focused on how high they climbed during a recent ropes course activity, a topic that produced enthusiastic
